CHAPTER 520.

AN ACT relating to the salaries of judges.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Salaries increased. SECTION 1. The judges of the circuit courts shall receive as salary, in addition to the amount now received, the sum of six hundred dollars per annum, payable quarterly, out of the state treasury.

To whom payable. SECTION 2. The increase of salaries hereby provided for shall be paid only to the circuit judges of said courts for terms of office hereafter to commence.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 521.

AN ACT to provide for the termination and forfeiture of franchises in certain cases.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Must be exercised within four years. SECTION 1. All franchises heretofore granted by the legislature for the building and maintaining of a dam or dams across any navigable stream in this state which have not been exercised by the commencement in good faith of the work of building such dam or dams within four years from the date of the passage and publication of this act shall be forfeited and terminated.
