CHAPTER 18.

AN ACT to appropriate to Charles P. Wallig, county treasurer of the county of Kenosha, a sum of money therein named.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of refunding money paid to the state by mistake, being an over-payment of the sum due the state for fines collected in the municipal court of Kenosha county under the provisions of section 719 of the statutes, there is appropriated to Charles P. Wallig, county treasurer of Kenosha county, Wisconsin, out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of two hundred ninety-seven dollars and twenty-eight cents.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 19.

AN ACT to appropriate to E. A. Cleasby a specified sum of money for unpaid salary and expenses as deputy fish and game warden.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated to E. A. Cleasby, out of any money in the general fund of the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of one hundred forty-nine dollars and thirty-five cents, a balance remaining unpaid for salary and expenses for services rendered during the months of March and April, 1912, as deputy fish and game warden.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
