CHAPTER 375.

AN ACT to amend section 172—46 of the statutes, making an appropriation for the Wisconsin academy of sciences, arts and letters.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 172—46 of the statutes is amended to read: Section 172—46. 1. There is annually appropriated, beginning July 1, * * * 1915, * * * *one thousand five hundred* dollars, payable from any moneys in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, for the Wisconsin academy of sciences, arts and letters for printing and to otherwise carry on the work of said society.

* * *

* * * 2. Moneys appropriated to the Wisconsin academy of sciences, arts and letters shall not be paid out of the state treasury until necessary to pay actual claims duly audited by the secretary of state.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of July 1, 1915.

CHAPTER 376.

AN ACT to amend subdivision (2) of subsection 1 of section 1494—33 of the statutes, relating to stallion enrollment.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subdivision (2) of subsection 1 of section 1494—33 of the statutes is amended to read: (Section 1494—33. 1.) (2) The studbooks and signatures of the duly authorized officers of the following American horse and jack pedigree registry associations, societies, or companies, certified by the department of agriculture, Washington, D. C., in Bureau of Animal Industry, Order No. 136, June 20, 1906, and in the amendments thereto:
