JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 1.

Relating to the death of Hon. Carl Zillier.

WHEREAS, Honorable Carl Zillier, an early settler of Sheboygan county, a much beloved and highly respected citizen of this state and a former member of the legislature of Wisconsin, died on the 15th day of April, 1914; and

WHEREAS, He was prominent in the public life of Sheboygan county and of this state—for many years Mr. Zillier was the chairman of the county board of supervisors of Sheboygan county; in the legislature of 1863, he was the youngest member of that body and in the legislature of 1913, the oldest; and

WHEREAS, In all his public life, Mr. Zillier carefully, efficiently and honorably discharged the duties of the various trusts reposed in him; therefore, be it

Resolved, by the Assembly, the Senate concurring, That as an expression of our appreciation and admiration of his important service to the state, this memorial be entered in the proceedings of this day; and be it further

Resolved, That a copy of these resolutions, signed by the presiding officers and chief clerks of the assembly and senate, be transmitted to the family of the deceased.
