CHAPTER 395

AN ACT to create sections 1421—31, 1421—32 and 1421—33, and a new subsection of section 20.17, of the statutes, to establish the northern state tuberculosis sanatorium, and making an appropriation.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There are added to the statutes three new sections to be numbered and to read:

Section 1421—31. There is established a new institution, to be located north of the center line of the state, and to be known as the northern state tuberculosis sanatorium, for the treatment of pulmonary tuberculosis, and especially for cases in the incipient and moderately advanced stages. The state board of control shall construct the necessary buildings for such sanatorium on lands owned by the state if in the judgment of said board any such lands will furnish a site which is appropriate and practicable; otherwise said board is authorized to purchase a suitable site at a price of not to exceed twenty-five dollars an acre.

Section 1421—32. The provisions of sections 1421—1 to 1421—8 shall apply to and govern said institution.

Section 1421—33. The state board of control is authorized to erect on such site, and equip, such buildings as it deems proper, to meet the demands for the admission of persons afflicted with tuberculosis.

SECTION 2. There is added to section 20.17 of the statutes, a new subsection to be numbered and to read:

(20.17) (28) For the northern state tuberculosis sanatorium, on July 1, 1917, seventy-five thousand dollars, for the purchase of a site and the erection and equipment of buildings.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon July 1, 1917.
