

matter of justice to the management of the House of Good Shepherd and for the information of the general public of this state, a joint committee of the legislature consisting of three assemblymen to be appointed by the speaker, and two senators to be appointed by the presiding officer of the senate, be constituted to fully investigate the existing conditions at the House of Good Shepherd, and also the management and all other officers connected with the publication of the *Kuryer Polski*.

The said committee is invested with plenary powers to perform and discharge the duties by this resolution enjoined, and in the exercise of such power, it may, among other things, by subpoena issued over the signature of the chairman of said committee, and served in the manner that circuit court subpoenas are served, summon and compel the attendance of witnesses, and the production of all books, papers, documents and records necessary or convenient to be examined or used by them as evidence. They may also either as a committee or through a proper person authorized by them, examine all books, papers, documents and records relating to any matter mentioned herein, and may do all other things which may to them appear necessary or convenient to make full examination and investigation as directed herein. Said committee shall have power to employ such counsel, stenographers, clerks and assistants as may be necessary and may, by any member thereof, administer oaths to all persons brought or appearing before it.

The said committee shall with all reasonable dispatch discharge the duties hereby imposed, and shall submit a report to this session of the legislature of its findings and recommendations.

JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 23.

To amend section 21 of article IV of the constitution, relating to compensation of members of the legislature.

*Resolved by the Assembly, the Senate concurring, That section 21 of Article IV of the constitution be amended to read: (Article IV) Section 21. Each member of the legislature shall receive for his services \* \* \* such sum \* \* \* to be paid at such times and in such manner as shall be prescribed by law. \* \* \* The compensation prescribed for members of the legislature immediately prior to the adoption of this amendment shall continue in force until changed by the legislature in a manner consistent with the other provisions of this constitution.*
