

Wisconsin Session Laws, 1919

CHAPTER 1.

AN ACT relating to expert and clerical assistants for the joint committee on finance, and making an appropriation therefor.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The joint committee on finance and the legislature of the session of 1919 are empowered to employ trained experts in accounting and statistics and such other assistants as may be necessary. Such experts and assistants shall be exempt from the provisions of chapter 16 and subsection 1 of section 13.14 of the 1917 statutes.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general fund for the legislative sessions of 1919 a sum, sufficient to carry out the provisions of this act, not to exceed thirty-five hundred dollars, the same to be paid upon the approval and order of the chairmen of the senate and assembly divisions of the joint committee on finance. Said appropriation to be available for any bills for help incurred by the committee since the date of its organization.

This act shall take effect as of January 14, 1919.

CHAPTER 2.

AN ACT relating to the purchase of furniture, furnishings and equipment by the superintendent of public property, and making an appropriation therefor.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the superintendent of public property for the purchase of furniture, furnishings and equipment for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1919, an amount not to exceed twenty-five hundred dollars.
