## CHAPTER 274.

AN ACT to create a new paragraph of subsection (11) of section 20.17 of the statutes, relating to the Southern Wisconsin Home for Feeble-Minded, and making appropriations. *The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. There is added to subsection (11) of section 20.17 of the statutes, a new paragraph to be numbered and to read: (20.17) (11) (e) On July 1, 1919, seventeen thousand five hundred dollars, for main sewer extension; thirty-five thousand dollars, for the construction of inmate buildings; twenty-five thousand dollars, for the construction of a refectory; twenty-five thousand dollars, for the construction of two employes' buildings; thirty-three thousand dollars, for the construction of the power and heat station; thirty thousand dollars, for heat and light apparatus; five thousand dollars for the construction of a chimney; twenty thousand dollars, for tunnels, conduits, sewers and water supply; ten thousand dollars, for a well; six thousand dollars, for roads and sidewalks; five thousand dollars, for sidetrack; one thousand nine hundred and fifty dollars, for screens; one thousand five hundred dollars, for porch and other improvements at the superintendent's residence; one thousand five hundred dollars, for fences; one thousand two hundred and fifty dollars, for remodeling farm house; and three thousand five hundred dollars, for general supervision of construction.

And on July 1, 1920, two hundred forty thousand dollars, for the construction of inmate buildings; twenty-five thousand dollars, for the construction of the refectory; twenty-five thousand dollars, for the construction of the two employes' buildings; thirty thousand dollars, for heat and light apparatus; thirty thousand dollars, for tunnels, conduits, sewers and water supply; twenty-five thousand dollars, for the construction of a laundry; thirty-two thousand dollars, for furniture and furnishings for the four buildings; eight thousand dollars, for furniture and furnishings for the two employes' buildings; six thousand dollars, for furniture and furnishings, and equipment of the refectory; six thousand dollars, for laundry machinery; twelve thousand dollars, for farm buildings; and three thousand five hundred dollars, for general supervision of construction.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon July 1, 1919.
