CHAPTER 162.

AN ACT to amend subsection (16) of section 6.23 of the statutes, relating to form of ballot in judicial and school elections.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (16) of section 6.23 of the statutes is amended to read: (6.23) (16) Ballots for judicial, school and city elections shall be printed upon the quality of white print paper hereinbefore specified, and shall be of sufficient size to afford space for the names of the several candidates for any office in the column under the proper office designation. The names of candidates for judicial offices and school superintendent shall be printed on the same ballot in substantially the annexed form marked "E". Such ballots shall have similar matter printed on the back and outside as other official ballots are required to have.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
