### CHAPTER 212.

**AN ACT** to amend paragraphs (c) and (d) of subsection (6) of section 20.60 of the statutes, relating to the construction of a grand stand and a tunnel, and the construction and equipment of an addition to the dairy building on the state fair grounds.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

**SECTION 1.** Paragraphs (c) and (d) of subsection (6) of section 20.60 of the statutes are amended to read: (20.60) (6) (c) On July 1, 1918, fifty thousand dollars, and on July 1, 1919, fifty thousand dollars, and on July 1, 1921, fifty thousand dollars, for construction of a grand stand *and for the construction and equipment of an addition to the dairy building on the state fair grounds.*

(d) On July 1, 1921, not to exceed twenty-five thousand dollars for the • • • *construction and equipment of an addition to the dairy building on the state fair grounds.*

**SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

### CHAPTER 213.

**AN ACT** to appropriate a sum of money named herein to the Wisconsin Deep Waterways Commission, created by chapter 377, laws of 1919.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the general fund to the Wisconsin Deep Waterways Commission, created by chapter 377, laws of 1919, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1926, six thousand two hundred fifty dollars; and for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1927, six thousand two hundred fifty dollars, for the execution of its functions, provided that no part of this appropriation shall be available except upon the approval of the governor, and provided further, that the members of said commission shall receive their actual expenses but no compensation.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on July 1, 1925.

#### CHAPTER 214.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money therein named to reimburse Elmer S. Hall and John S. Donald for legal expenses in the case of state of Wisconsin vs. Gottlieb Krause and others.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from any moneys in the general fund, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of two hundred dollars to Elmer S. Hall and the sum of two hundred dollars to John S. Donald to reimburse them for moneys paid to Olbrich, Brown and Siebecker, attorneys, of Madison, Wisconsin, for legal services rendered in their behalf in the case of state of Wisconsin vs. Gottlieb Krause and others, in which case the said Elmer S. Hall and John S. Donald were each interpleaded as a defendant while holding the office of secretary of state of Wisconsin.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
