

pensation provided by law for the phonographic reporter of the circuit court for Dane county. The appointment of said reporter shall be filed in writing with the county clerk of Dane county. The reporter so appointed may appoint a deputy as provided in the circuit court for Dane county.

SECTION 3. The term of office of August C. Hoppman, as senior judge of the superior court shall terminate at midnight of the thirtieth day of April, 1925.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect on April 30, 1925.

CHAPTER 8.

AN ACT to amend subsection (2) of section 20.63 of the statutes, relating to the purchase of law books, books of reference and binding books for the State Law Library, and making an appropriation.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (2) of section 20.63 is amended to read: Section 20.63 (2) On July 1, * * * 1925, six thousand five hundred dollars; and on July 1, * * * 1926, six thousand five hundred dollars, for the purchase of such law books, books of reference, and works on political science and statistics, and for binding books, for the state library and the justices of the supreme court, as the said board shall think reasonably necessary or desirable. Expenditures from this appropriation shall be certified to the secretary of state by the state librarian.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1925.
