CHAPTER 282.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money therein specified to the town of Lincoln, Forest county, to reimburse it for the expenses incurred in extinguishing forest fires in 1925.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the conservation fund the sum of nine hundred and ninety-one dollars and fifty-seven cents to the town of Lincoln, Forest county, to reimburse it for moneys spent in extinguishing forest fires in 1925.

CHAPTER 283.

AN ACT to amend section 66.14 of the statutes, relating to the expense of fidelity bonds to be paid by cities.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 66.14 of the statutes is amended to read: 66.14 Any city * * * , however incorporated, may pay the cost of any official bond furnished by an officer thereof, pursuant to law or any rules or regulations requiring the same, if said officer shall furnish a bond with a surety company or companies authorized to do business in this state, said cost not to exceed the current rate of premium per annum on the amount of said bond
