

ded fifty thousand inhabitants or more, or in any city, town or village, to be maintained in whole or in part by public funds unless such county, city, town or village, shall jointly or severally agree to furnish as a minimum in the joint enterprise, suitable quarters for such office, which must be approved by the industrial commission and to pay all expenses for such quarters such as rent, heat, light, furniture, telephone rental and janitor service. The industrial commission may defray all other expenses in connection with such office. Provided, further, that in any county, city, village or town therein, wherein there is a citizens' committee on unemployment, such committee shall have the power to rent, lease, purchase or construct necessary buildings for the joint establishment and maintenance of such free employment office.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 309.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to the executive department as an emergency appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1927.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the general fund to the executive department five hundred dollars as an emergency appropriation for operation, in addition to all other sums heretofore appropriated for that purpose, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1927.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
