CHAPTER 42.

AN ACT to amend the introductory paragraphs of subsection (1) of section 102.11 of the statutes, relating to the maximum wage under the workmen's compensation act.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The introductory paragraphs of subsection (1) of section 102.11 of the statutes are amended to read: (102.11) (1) (Introductory paragraphs) The average weekly earnings referred to in section 102.09 shall be one-fiftieth of the average annual earnings of the employe.

The average annual earnings for employes shall be taken at not less than five hundred twenty-five dollars nor more than one thousand * * * five hundred dollars per annum. Between said limits such average annual earnings shall be determined as follows:

CHAPTER 43.

AN ACT to amend section 193.02 of the statutes, relating to electric roads.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:
