CHAPTER 105.

AN ACT to create section 29.36 of the statutes, relating to issuing and wearing of conservation buttons with hunting, fishing and trapping licenses and providing a penalty.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. A new section is added to the statutes to read:
29.36 (1) The conservation commission shall devise, secure, issue and deliver to each person applying for a license under sections 29.10, 29.11, 29.12, 29.13, 29.14, subsection (3) of sections 29.22, 29.35 and 29.38, an official conservation button.

(2) Such button shall be worn in a conspicuous place on the front of outer upper garment, cap or hat, at the same time that such license shall be carried on the person. Any person violating the provisions of this subsection shall be punished by a fine of not less than five dollars nor more than twenty-five dollars.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 106.

AN ACT to amend section 45.055 of the statutes, relating to memorials to soldiers, sailors and marines who served the nation in the Spanish-American war.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 45.055 of the statutes is amended to read:
45.055 County boards are empowered to provide for the erection or establishment of suitable memorials to the soldiers, sailors and marines of the respective counties of this state who served the nation during the *Spanish-American war or the late war against Germany and its allies*, or to contribute funds to corporations of the respective counties organized without capital stock for the purpose of erecting and completing such memorials; and for the purpose of raising funds for such memorial purposes or contributions to levy taxes upon the taxable property of the county
