CHAPTER 226.

AN ACT to create subsection (10) of section 83.04 and subsection (8) of section 84.06 of the statutes, relating to the construction of cattle passes on federal aid highway systems.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. A new subsection is added to section 83.04 and a new subsection is added to section 84.06 of the statutes to read: (83.04)(10) The county highway committee of each county may construct cattle passes on such portions of the federal aid highway systems, laid out in accordance with the act of congress relating to federal aid highways dated November 9, 1921, and completed to date in such county, as in the opinion of said committee are necessary and practical. Such construction work shall be done as soon as possible and in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 83, and the expense thereof may be paid from any construction or surplus maintenance funds accruing to such county under the provisions of section 20.49 and from any funds allotted to such county as state aid under the provisions of subsection (9) of section 84.03. If such funds are insufficient, the county board may provide for the necessary additional funds by tax levy.

(84.06) (8) In making any highway improvement under the provisions of this section, cattle passes shall be constructed as a part of such improvement at such places as may be determined necessary and practical.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
