CHAPTER 232.

AN ACT to repeal section 60.50 of the statutes, relating to the allotment of town funds in cases of deficiency.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 60.50 of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 233.

AN ACT to amend subsection (13) of section 59.07 of the statutes, relating to county aid to school districts in which state institutions are located.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (13) of section 59.07 of the statutes is amended to read: (59.07) (13) Appropriate to any school district in which a county farm or a state charitable or penal institution or any state-owned lands which are used for agricultural purposes or any part thereof is situated, an amount of money for school purposes equal to the amount that would be paid as school taxes upon such farm land or part thereof situated within such district if such land were privately owned. The valuation of such farm land shall be determined by the county board of equalization.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
