CHAPTER 279.

AN ACT to amend the introductory paragraph of subsection (1) of section 59.21 of the statutes, relating to the appointment of undersheriffs.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The introductory paragraph of subsection (1) of section 59.21 of the statutes is amended to read: (59.21) (1) (Introductory paragraph) Within ten days after entering upon the duties of his office the sheriff shall appoint some proper person, resident of his county, undersheriff, * * * *provided that in counties with a population of five hundred thousand or more the appointment of an undersheriff shall be optional; and within such time the sheriff shall appoint deputy sheriffs for his county as follows:*

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 280.

AN ACT to renumber section 75.66 of the statutes to be subsection (1) of said section and to create subsection (2) of said section, relating to collection of taxes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 75.66 of the statutes is renumbered to be subsection (1) of said section.

SECTION 2. A new subsection is added to section 75.66 of the statutes to be numbered and to read: (75.66) (2) Any county treasurer to whom special assessments for improvements have been or may be returned, in lieu of cash pursuant to the provisions of section 62.21, may likewise institute and prosecute an action to collect the same in the name of the county when authorized so to do by the county board of supervisors.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
