JOINT RESOLUTION

Relating to the interim legislative committee to investigate farm machinery prices.

WHEREAS, The legislature in the special session of 1931-1932, in Joint Resolution No. 34, created an interim committee to investigate farm machinery prices and to make recommendations to the present legislature for legislation to secure a reduction in these prices; and

WHEREAS, Because this committee was given no appropriation, it has been impossible for it to complete its investigation prior to the opening of the session of the present legislature; and

WHEREAS, This is a subject in which the farmers of the state are very much interested; therefore, be it

Resolved by the Senate, the Assembly concurring, That the interim committee created by Joint Resolution No. 34, Special Session of 1931-1932, is hereby continued, with all of the duties and powers conferred upon it in said joint resolution. This committee shall proceed promptly to complete its investigation and shall make a report to this legislature, with its recommendations, not later than April 1, 1933.
