CHAPTER 215.

AN ACT to create 194.34 (5) of the statutes, relating to discrimination by contract motor carriers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Subsection (5) of section 194.34 of the statutes is created to read:

(194.34) (5) No contract motor carrier shall unreasonably or unjustly discriminate in the furnishing of service or the charging of rates therefor with respect to the transportation of any such commodities or any such description or class of traffic as he is authorized by his license to furnish to the public generally or to any class thereof. Any unjust or unreasonable discriminatory rate or practice of such a carrier with respect to such transportation is declared unlawful and is hereby prohibited.

CHAPTER 216.

AN ACT to repeal and recreate 97.09 (9) of the statutes, relating to manufacturers, bottlers and wholesalers of soda water beverages.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Subsection (9) of section 97.09 of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

(97.09) (9) No soft drink or other nonalcoholic beverage, except apple cider, not manufactured in this state shall be sold or offered for sale in this state unless the person, firm or corporation manufacturing such drink shall first obtain a regular Wisconsin state license as provided for in this section and shall otherwise comply with all the provisions of this section.
