

thereon shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the municipality at least 10 days prior to the time of such public hearing. In towns or one room school districts, a summary of such budget and notice of the time and place of the public hearing shall be posted in three public places at least 10 days prior to the time of such public hearing.

(4) Not less than 14 days after the publication of the proposed budget and the notice of hearing thereon a public hearing shall be held at the time and place stipulated at which time any resident or taxpayer of the governmental unit shall have an opportunity to be heard on the proposed budget. The budget hearing may be adjourned from time to time.

(5) The amount of tax to be levied or certified, the amounts of the various appropriations and the purposes for such appropriations stated in such budget, after any alterations therein made pursuant to the hearing required by this section, shall not be changed thereafter unless authorized by a vote of two-thirds of the entire membership of the governing body of such municipality. Any municipality, excepting towns and one room school districts, which makes such changes shall give notice thereof by publication, within 8 days thereafter, in a newspaper in general circulation in such municipality.

SECTION 2. Paragraph (c) of subsection (14) of section 73.03 of the statutes is created to read:

(73.03) (14) (c) The municipal accounting division shall assist local units of government to install improved budgetary methods, and no charge shall be made for such assistance. Such division shall also upon request transmit proposed basic budget forms to each local unit of government.

### CHAPTER 222.

AN ACT to create 29.545 of the statutes, relating to removal of aquatic plants from certain waters and providing a penalty.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 29.545 of the statutes is created to read:

29.545 REMOVAL OF AQUATIC PLANTS FROM WATERS PROHIBITED. No person shall cut, harvest or remove wild rice, wild celery, sago or other aquatic plants of any variety whatsoever from Lakes Partridge, Partridge Crop, Poygan, Winnebconne, Big Lake Butte des Morts, and the Wolf River from the mouth of the Rat River to its outlet from Big Lake Butte des Morts, except that wild celery and sago may be cut, harvested or removed from Big Lake Butte des Morts and from the Fox River from its junction with the Wolf River to where it empties into Lake Winnebago.

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### CHAPTER 223.

AN ACT to create 129.17 of the statutes, relating to prohibiting peddling finger alphabet cards and providing a penalty.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. A section of the statutes is created to read:

129.17 PEDDLING FINGER ALPHABET CARDS PROHIBITED. No person shall in this state engage in the business of peddling finger alphabet cards or use finger alphabet cards in any way as a means of inducement in the sale of merchandise; and no state or local license as provided in this chapter shall be issued to any person for the purpose of peddling finger alphabet cards. Any person who shall peddle finger alphabet cards or use finger alphabet cards in any way as a means of inducement in the sale of merchandise in this state and any person who shall issue any state or local license as provided in this chapter for that purpose shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by imprisonment in the county jail not more than 60 days or by a fine of not less than \$10 nor more than \$50.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
