CHAPTER 324.

AN ACT to create 64.11 (8) of the statutes, relating to limitations on power of city manager in event of establishment of civil service system.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (8) of section 64.11 of the statutes is created to read:

(64.11) (8) In the event that such a city has established under the provisions of section 66.19 a civil service system, then the powers and duties of the city manager as provided in this section shall be limited and governed by such rules and regulations as may be promulgated under such civil service system.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 325.

AN ACT to create 20.60 (32) and 100.07 of the statutes, relating to examination and audit of payments for milk in fluid markets or where the producer price varies according to different uses, and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (32) of section 20.60 of the statutes is created to read:

(20.60) (32) All money received under section 100.07 as a nonlapsible appropriation for the execution of functions pursuant to the provisions of said section.
