CHAPTER 35.

AN ACT to repeal 101.40 of the statutes, relating to licensing and regulating of painters.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 101.40 of the statutes is repealed.

CHAPTER 36.

AN ACT to authorize the city of Sheboygan to extend and maintain jetties into Lake Michigan from riparian lands therein described.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The city of Sheboygan is hereby authorized to build and maintain jetties into Lake Michigan for shore protection in front of the riparian lands of the city of Sheboygan hereinafter described, the number and length of said jetties to be determined by said city. The following is a description of the riparian lands from which said jetties may be extended, namely: the lake shore from the northern boundary of the City of Sheboygan to the southern boundary thereof.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
