

the county clerk, not more than 40 nor less than 25 days before such election; for candidates to be voted for wholly within one city in the office of the city clerk, not more than 20 nor less than 15 days before such election. Provided, that nomination papers proposing candidates for judicial offices, members of the board of supervisors or for school board directors in the cases provided for in subsection (8), shall be filed not more than 40 nor less than 20 days \* \* \* *Such nomination papers shall be filed not later than \* \* \* 5 p. m. central standard time on said last day before the primary therein provided for.*

### CHAPTER 108.

AN ACT to amend 40.04 (13) of the statutes, relating to salaries of members of common school district boards.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

40.04 (13) of the statutes is amended to read:

40.04 (13) To vote salaries to the members of the school board, but the salary to the treasurer and the director shall not exceed \* \* \* \$20 each and the salary to the clerk shall not exceed \* \* \* \$25, except that in districts with more than one common school the salary of each board member may be \$5 additional for each additional school, unless the district maintains a state graded or a high school. *Limitations herein set forth shall not apply to school districts operating first class state graded schools, high schools with grades or high schools.*
