

upon make an appointment from such list to fill such position within 10 days after the receipt of such eligible list. The county for which such examination is conducted shall pay the cost thereof. In the event that a civil service commission is decided upon for the selection of deputy sheriffs, then the provisions of sections 16.31 to 16.44 shall apply so far as consistent with this subsection, except sections 16.33, 16.34 and 16.43 and except the provision governing minimum compensation of the commissioners and except that such ordinance may provide for 3 commissioners. *Except that for the duration of the present war (World War II) and until its termination as proclaimed by the President or the Congress and for one year thereafter in counties appointing deputy sheriffs under a civil service system, temporary appointments of deputy sheriffs may be made without complying with the civil service ordinance.*

CHAPTER 195.

AN ACT to create 59.08 (43) of the statutes, relating to special powers of county boards.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

59.08 (43) of the statutes is created to read:

59.08 (43) NURSING ASSOCIATIONS. To appropriate money toward the maintenance and support of duly organized and bona fide nursing associations in the county, such associations to have at least one qualified nurse.
