CHAPTER 336.

AN ACT to amend 20.17 (26) (introductory paragraph) and (a) (as amended by chapter 132, laws of 1943) and 20.41 (3) (a) of the statutes, relating to agricultural extension and emergency relief and making appropriations.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.17 (26) (introductory paragraph) and (a) of the statutes (as amended by chapter 132, laws of 1943) are amended to read:

20.17 (26) (Introductory paragraph) On July 1, 1943, * * * \$304,000, and on July 1, 1944, * * * \$304,000 for emergency relief. Of this there is allotted:

(a) * * * \$250,000 annually for distribution to counties and local units of government as direct aid for poor relief.

SECTION 2. 20.41 (3) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

20.41 (3) (a) Annually, beginning July 1, * * * 1943, \$150,000 for county agricultural representatives as provided in section 59.87, and agricultural extension as provided in section 36.215; and for the conduct of the soils laboratory, pursuant to section 36.20.
