

- (a) Provide educational leadership.
- (b) Visit the schools under his administration whenever necessary.
- (c) Inquire into matters relating to the course of study, records, modes of instruction, textbooks and discipline of the schools.
- (d) Keep informed upon new techniques and procedures of instruction.
- (e) Advise school boards and teachers as to their powers and duties.
- (f) Make all reports and investigations requested by the state superintendent.

CHAPTER 393.

AN ACT to amend 245.20 of the statutes, relating to marriage license records and blanks.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

245.20 of the statutes is amended to read:

245.20 The state registrar of vital statistics shall prescribe model forms for blank applications, statement, consent of parents, affidavits, licenses, and marriage certificates and other such forms as shall be necessary to comply with the provisions of this * * * chapter. The county clerk shall keep in his office among his records, *a suitable book to be called the marriage license docket* and enter therein a complete record of the applications for, and the issuing of all marriage licenses, and of all other matters which he is required by this * * * chapter to ascertain relative to the rights of any person to obtain a license. Said marriage license docket shall be open for public inspection or examination at all times during office hours. * * *
