CHAPTER 60.

AN ACT appropriating a certain sum to the adjutant general conditionally upon the national encampment of the G. A. R. coming to Wisconsin in 1943.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

There is appropriated from the general fund to the adjutant general the sum of \$2,000 as a nonlapsible appropriation to be used in connection with the national encampment of the Grand Army of the Republic in the event that it accepts the invitation to come to Wisconsin in 1943. Allotments from this appropriation shall be made at such times and in such amounts as the adjutant general may certify to the secretary of state. This appropriation shall become available upon the condition that the national encampment of the Grand Army of the Republic is held in Wisconsin in 1943.

CHAPTER 61.

AN ACT to amend 97.42 (1) (a) of the statutes, relating to oleomargarine.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

97.42 (1) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

97.42 (1) (a) An occupational tax is hereby assessed, imposed and levied, as hereinafter provided, upon the sale, offering or exposing for sale, or giving or delivering or use of oleomargarine, butterine and similar substances, in this state. The purpose of this section is declared to be the raising of revenue, and the regulations herein imposed are for the purpose of securing the full collection of such revenue, and punishing evasion or attempted evasion of the payment thereof. Oleomargarine, butterine and similar substances include * * * all fats and fat compounds sufficiently adaptable to * * * the ordinary uses of butter, to lead readily to use as an alternative to butter.
