CHAPTER 105.

AN ACT to amend 27.05 (3) of the statutes, relating to the power of county park commissions to acquire land for park or parkway purposes in adjoining counties.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

27.05 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

27.05 (3) To acquire, in the name of the county, by purchase, land contract, lease, condemnation, or otherwise, with the approval and consent of the county board, such tracts of land or public ways as it may deem suitable for park purposes; *including lands in any other county not more than three-fourths of a mile from the county line*; but no land so acquired shall be disposed of by the county without the consent of said commission, and all moneys received for any such lands, or any materials, so disposed of, shall be paid into the county park fund hereinafter established.
