CHAPTER 116.

AN ACT to create 61.305 of the statutes, relating to police justice of the peace in villages.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

61.305 of the statutes is created to read:

61.305 POLICE JUSTICE OF THE PEACE. The village board of any village may create the office of police justice of the peace in the manner provided by section 62.24, and thereupon such court shall have the same jurisdiction as provided by section 62.24 including the jurisdiction with respect to village ordinances as for city ordinances under section 62.24 irrespective of the provisions of section 61.30.
