CHAPTER 122.

AN ACT to amend 192.29 (4) of the statutes, relating to whistles and bells on railroads.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

192.29 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

192.29 (4) No railroad train or locomotive shall run over any public traveled grade highway crossing outside of the limits of municipalities unless the whistle *or horn* shall be blown 80 rods from such crossing and the engine bell rung continuously from thence until such crossing be reached. But the public service commission may order that the ringing of the bell or the blowing of the whistle, *or horn*, or both, as required by this subsection shall be omitted at any crossing.
