CHAPTER 135.

AN ACT to create 85.10 (21) (g) of the statutes, relating to pedestrian ways.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

85.10 (21) (g) of the statutes is created to read:

85.10 (21) (g) Pedestrian way shall mean a walk designated for the use of pedestrian travel. Public utilities may be installed either above or below a pedestrian way, and assessments may be made therefor as if such pedestrian way were a highway, street, alley, roadway or sidewalk. All of the applicable provisions of chapter 85 pertaining to highways, streets, alleys, roadways and sidewalks shall apply to a pedestrian way.
