CHAPTER 162.

AN ACT to amend 90.15 of the statutes, relating to fees of fence viewers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

90.15 of the statutes is amended to read:

90.15 Each fence viewer shall, for services rendered by him in accordance with the provisions of this chapter, be entitled to the following fees, viz: * * * \$3 per day for the time he shall be so necessarily employed; for each mile actually and necessarily traveled in the performance of any service required, * * * 5 cents; * * * 50 cents for serving any notice or other process upon each person named therein and twelve cents per folio for all writing required and actually done. Said fees shall be paid by the parties to the controversy, equally, and if they or any of them shall neglect to pay the same within * * * 30 days after the services shall have been performed each fence viewer may recover from delinquent parties jointly double the amount of such fees. Any fence viewer who, when requested, unreasonably neglects to perform any duty required of him shall forfeit * * * \$5, and be liable to the party injured for all damages consequent upon such neglect. In the performance of any duty required under this chapter fence viewers may administer oaths.
