CHAPTER 200.

AN ACT to create 366.21 of the statutes, relating to the establishment of fees for certain services rendered by the medical examiner in counties having a population of 500,000 or more.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

366.21 of the statutes is created to read:

366.21 FEES FOR MORGUE SERVICES. In counties having a population of 500,000 or more, there shall be a \$2 per day fee for the retention of a body at the morgue after the third day, but such charge shall not apply to indigents.
