**CHAPTER 217.**

AN ACT to amend 66.19 (2) of the statutes, relating to civil service systems in populous towns.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

66.19 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

66.19 (2) Any town with a population of more than \* \* \* 5,000 inhabitants may proceed under section 60.29 (1) to establish a civil service system as provided under subsection (1) \* \* \* and in such departments as the town board may determine. Any person who shall have been employed in any such department for more than 5 years prior to the establishment of such civil service shall be eligible to appointment without examination.
