**CHAPTER 218.**

AN ACT to create 1.10 of the statutes, relating to the Wisconsin state tree, flower and bird.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

1.10 of the statutes is created to read:

1.10 STATE TREE, FLOWER, BIRD. The Wisconsin state tree is the sugar maple (*acer saccharum*); the Wisconsin state flower is the wood violet (*viola papilionacea*); the Wisconsin state bird is the robin (*turdus migratorius*).
