CHAPTER 254.

AN ACT to create 14.74 of the statutes, relating to state agencies charging for certain printed booklets and pamphlets prepared or compiled by them for distribution.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

14.74 of the statutes is created to read:

14.74 CHARGES FOR PRINTED BOOKLETS AND PAMPHLETS. Except where distribution to or exchange with specified persons, officers or agencies is provided by law, or where

the state agency determines that distribution is to be free of charge, any state agency may make such charge for printed booklets and pamphlets prepared or compiled by it as shall be fixed by it, provided a written statement by the state agency to the bureau of purchases justifying the making and the amount of such charge has accompanied the printing requisition or is filed with said bureau before any such charge is made. Such charge shall not exceed the cost of publication and handling, and shall be consistent with any sale price otherwise fixed or provided by law. If the agency so determines such booklets or pamphlets may be retained by or delivered to the bureau of purchases for sale and distribution.
