CHAPTER 359.

AN ACT to amend 35.07 (2) of the statutes, relating to the ordering of printing and office supplies used by the sergeant at arms.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

35.07 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

35.07 (2) At the opening of the session, each chief clerk shall be provided by the director of purchases with a printing order book containing blank orders and stubs, numbered in duplicate, and whenever such chief clerk delivers to the state printer an order for printing, he shall immediately transmit to the director of purchases a carbon copy of such order upon the corresponding duplicate order blank. *Each sergeant at arms may order such envelopes with or without return address printed thereon and such office supplies as are necessary in the performance of his duties.*
