CHAPTER 362.

AN ACT to create 77.15 of the statutes, relating to forest crop lands.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 77.15 of the statutes is created to read:

77.15 SPECIAL CLASSIFICATION. Any tract of land of not less than 40 acres, lying outside the boundary of forest protection districts, may be entered under the provisions of this chapter, but the following modifications shall apply:

(a) The commission order of entry shall be stamped in red ink with the words "special classification," and the designation on the tax roll shall also be in red ink.

(b) The acreage share on such lands shall be 20 cents; no state contribution shall be paid and no severance tax levied.

(c) Use of such lands for grazing or any other purpose except forestry shall be cause for withdrawal under the provisions of section 77.10 (2).
