CHAPTER 369.

AN ACT to create 133.245 of the statutes, relating to trusts and monopolies.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

133.245 of the statutes is created to read:

133.245 ACTION TO CANCEL OR REVOKE CHARTER; JUDGMENT. In any action to forfeit, cancel, revoke or annul the charter of any corporation organized under the laws of this state, or the license or authority to do business in this state of any foreign corporation,

or to enjoin any such corporation from doing business in this state, because of violation of any provision relating to the unlawful restraint of trade or commerce, judgment for such forfeiture, cancellation, revocation, annulment or injunction may, upon such terms as the court shall deem just and in the public interest, be rendered by the court, but only upon proof of a substantial and willful violation of such statutory provision.
