CHAPTER 386.

AN ACT to create 16.105 (1m) of the statutes, relating to classification of state employes and the number and classifications in the several state departments.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

16.105 (1m) of the statutes is created to read:

16.105 (1m) After consultation with the appointing authorities, the director shall allocate each position in the competitive division of the classified service to an appropriate class in the classification plan on the basis of its duties, authority and responsibilities. He shall likewise reallocate positions from class to class on the same basis whenever he finds such action to be warranted. An establishment list shall be maintained by the director for each employing unit showing by classes the types and number of positions that have been established and maintained. The board after considering the recommendation of the director shall provide in its rules the procedure for establishing, discontinuing and abolishing positions.
