CHAPTER 400.

AN ACT to appropriate a certain sum therein named to the Marinette Marine Corporation in payment for repairs to the fishing tug owned by Lloyd Topel.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

There is appropriated from the conservation fund to the Marinette Marine Corporation of Marinette, Wisconsin, the sum of \$315.06, in payment for repairs to the fishing tug "Ann" owned by Lloyd Topel of Marinette, Wisconsin, such fishing tug having been damaged by the state conservation commission patrol boat "Barney Devine" in the waters of Green Bay on September 25, 1948. Acceptance of this appropriation shall operate as a final and complete settlement of any claim against the state on the part of the Marinette Marine Corporation and on the part of Lloyd Topel on account of such damages.
