

CHAPTER 408.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money therein named to Dodge county for reimbursement of certain expenses of trials of central state hospital cases.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

There is appropriated from the general fund to Dodge county the sum of \$770.95, to reimburse said county for the expense of trials of the following central state hospital cases under section 51.225 of Wisconsin statutes of 1945:

Victor Shaul	59.10

Said sums of money are not collectible by said county either because the trials of such persons resulted in discharge by the court or jury or by the doctors, or are not collectible under the 1945 law from the county of residence under an opinion of the attorney-general or because psychiatric services were ordered employed by the district attorney and no provision for repayment thereof appears in said statute. Acceptance of said amount shall operate as a full and complete release and discharge to the state of any claim arising therefrom.
