

CHAPTER 41.

AN ACT to amend 181.04 (1) of the statutes, relating to title to property after dissolution of corporation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

181.04 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

181.04 (1) Whenever any domestic corporation shall have been dissolved, owning any real property in this state, the resolution of dissolution required by section 181.03 to be recorded with the register of deeds of the county in which such corporation is located, *or in the case of any corporation which was dissolved prior to June 29, 1945, owning any interest in real estate, the affidavit of the person who was the president or the secretary of such corporation at the date of its dissolution stating the names of the persons holding stock in said corporation and the number of shares or proportional interest of said persons in the corporate property at such date, when recorded with the register of deeds of the county in which such corporation was located,* shall be prima facie evidence of the title of said persons in said corporate property.
