CHAPTER 445.

AN ACT to create 66.34 of the statutes, relating to authorizing counties and municipalities to perform certain work for privately owned lands and roads.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.34 of the statutes is created to read:

66.34 SOIL CONSERVATION; PRIVATE ROADS. Any county, city, village or town by its governing body or through a committee designated by it for the purpose, may contract to do soil conservation work on privately owned lands, but no such contract shall involve more than \$200 for any one person.
