CHAPTER 621.

AN ACT authorizing and directing the state department of public welfare to convey certain state owned lands in the town of Allouez, Brown county, Wisconsin, therein described to said town of Allouez.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

The state department of public welfare is authorized and directed to convey, for street or highway purposes, without receiving any consideration therefor, to the town of Allouez, Brown county, that part of the south one-half of private claim No. 19 on the east side of the Fox River, town of Allouez, Brown county, Wisconsin described and bounded as follows:

On the north by the east and west center line of said private claim No. 19, on the west by the east line of Du Charme Lane, on the south by a line 30 feet southerly of and parallel with said east and west center line of private claim No. 19, and on the east by a line 345.38 feet easterly of and parallel with said easterly line of Du Charme Lane.
