CHAPTER 103.

AN ACT to amend 85.45 (2) (d) of the statutes, relating to the height of motor vehicles.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

85.45 (2) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:

85.45 (2) (d) The maximum over-all height of any motor vehicle, trailer or semi-trailer shall not exceed 12½ feet *or when auto carriers, commonly known as "drive aways", specially constructed to carry and transport motor vehicles 13½ feet*, except as provided by section 85.53. The limitation of total height in this paragraph shall not be construed as requiring a clearance of such height or as relieving the owners of vehicles not exceeding such total height from liability for any damage.
