CHAPTER 364.

AN ACT to create 158.03 (4) of the statutes, relating to examination of instructors in schools teaching barbering.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

158.03 (4) of the statutes is created to read:

158.03 (4) No person shall engage in teaching or instructing students or apprentices in any school or college teaching barbering unless he holds a Wisconsin master barber's license, is a graduate from an approved high school or its equivalent as determined by examination by the state board of vocational and adult education and has passed an examination for an instructor's certificate in barbering. The examination shall cover such subjects as are usually taught in barber schools and colleges in practical work and theory. The examination fee for instructors shall be \$10.
