CHAPTER 435.

AN ACT to amend 66.315 (1) of the statutes, relating to policemen's benefits when acting outside own municipality.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.315 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

66.315 (1) Any chief of police, county traffic officer or other peace officer of any city, village or town, who shall be required by command of the governor, sheriff or other superior authority to maintain the peace or who shall respond to the request of the authorities of another municipality, to perform police or peace duties outside territorial limits of the city, village or town where employed as such officer, shall be entitled to the same wage, salary, pension, workmen's compensation, and all other service rights for such service as for service rendered within the limits of the city, village or town where regularly employed.
