CHAPTER 468.

AN ACT to amend 60.74 (7) of the statutes, relating to power of towns to enact zoning ordinances.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

60.74 (7) of the statutes is amended to read:

60.74 (7) Town boards * * * granted village powers by resolution adopted pursuant to section 60.18 (12) shall have power to adopt town zoning ordinances in the manner provided in section 61.35 notwithstanding any provision of this section or section 60.75 provided, however, that in counties which have adopted a zoning ordinance under section 59.97 the exercise of the power to adopt a town zoning ordinance shall be subject to approval by a referendum vote of the electors of the town held at the time of any regular annual town meeting. Any zoning ordinance adopted by a town board and any amendment thereof under this subsection shall be subject to the approval of the county board in counties having a county zoning ordinance.
